Why attend?

Family leaders will gain knowledge & information to meaningfully engage as stakeholders in conversations about data. This will help them effectively advocate for improving Part C/619 systems in their states. Information & resources about the data being collected by Part C/619 programs (at the local, state, and national levels) will help family leaders advocate for open and transparent conversations about improving the quality of the data and data systems. The learning experience will focus on how data can be used as a powerful tool for improving programs and improving child outcomes. Participants will be provided with resources that they can take back to their own states to use with other families to prepare and encourage more families to become engaged in conversations about data and data systems.
